strategies. The site for this important ceremony was the Guoman Tower Convention Hall of London, in the presence of an international audience

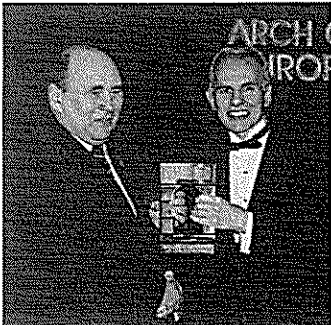
formed by business leaders who embrace innovation, bringing forth growth and development for their communities.

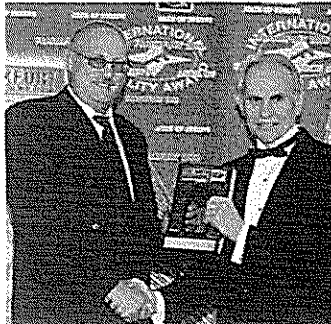

The BID criteria for excellence performance is based on the 100 percepts of the QC100 Total Quality Management Model which comprises areas like customer service, internal and external communication, benchmarking, information and analysis, human resources, decision making, systems and processes, business results, leadership, and the purchaser as a partner.

The correct application of these principles is currently helping companies in more than 173 countries improve their business results by focusing on two goals: the delivery of increased value products and services to customers and the enhancement of the organization's overall performance. Consequently the International Quality Crown Award recipients are imitated and admired in their countries.

The International Quality Crown Award, the "Nobel of the business world", is the pinnacle achievement for managers who make their companies sustainable by constant modernization and by paying attention to market tendencies.

The event which was presided by Jose E. Prieto, President and CEO of Business Initiative Directions, along with important personalities from the business world and the diplomatic corps in the United Kingdom, was a success due to its large number of participating business people and the leadership of the companies which participated.

This important event organized by Business Initiative Directions contributed to the prestige already acquired by other BID conventions celebrated in New York, Paris, Geneva, Frankfurt, Moscow, and Madrid. The latter is constructing in Dubai what will be the tallest building in the world whose goal for completion is aimed at the year 2008.

In this 2007 edition, the convention welcomed awarded companies such as Cooperativa Regional dos Cafeicultores de S.S. do Paraíso - Cooperaiso from Brazil, traded on the New York Stock Exchange and the BM&F and with more than 43 years of experience. As an internationally diversified coffee farming group, it undertakes specific actions to promote rural development in coffee producing areas, running its operations in an environmentally, socially and economically sustainable manner. Another outstanding leader, Aal Taher Group of Companies from Saudi Arabia, is one of the top 100 companies in the country.

Proponent of quality management as key to its country's prosperity and long-term economic strength, this organization is wholly committed to strengthening the private sector as a vital and dynamic part of the Saudi economy.

The representative of Aal Taher Group was followed on stage by the delegate of Envirotech Chem. Inc. from the USA, which was awarded for leadership in its sector. Special mention should be made to the participation of Polet Airlines from Cyprus.
